## Language Lab and CLIHLTS.

The institute also adheres to the dictums of preservation and conservation. **English** is the accepted mode of language in which exams of the institute are conducted. Therefore, it is mandatory for the students to be wellversed in the language. Though the institute relies on the language lab to dispense knowledge to students but the lab is always monitored and guided by the language teacher along with a lab assistant.
