<p>Purva Madhayama I in Buddhist Philosophy</p>	<p>47</p>	<p>In order to be considered for enrolment in Buddhist and Tibetan Studies, it is crucial that the student has a strong desire to learn and study in this field. Once this fundamental requirement is met, the student must also fulfil the following criteria.</p> <p>1. Candidates who have successfully completed the VIII standard from a recognized institution, with or without Tibetan Language as a subject, but possess a level of proficiency in Tibetan language equivalent to standard VIII, are eligible to take the entrance test, In addition, a level of proficiency in either English or Hindi equivalent to standard VIII is also required.</p>
<p>Uttar Madhayama I in Traditional Fine Arts</p>	<p>10</p>	<p>The foremost condition is that the student must possess a strong aspiration to pursue studies in arts and demonstrate the ability to undertake the language and grammar aspects of the program. Once this is established, the following requirements must be fulfilled.</p> <p>1.Candidates who have passed X standard from a recognized institution with Tibetan Language or without Tibetan Language as a subject, but possesses knowledge of Tibetan Language equivalent to standard X will be eligible to appear in the entrance test. Besides, knowledge of either English or Hindi equivalent to standard X is also required.</p>
<p>Uttar Madhayama I in Bhot Jyotish</p>	<p>07</p>	<p>The Primary requirement for enrolment in the Bhot Jyotish course is that the student must possess a strong desire and passion to pursue this field of study.</p> <p>Thereafter, the following requirements should be fulfilled.</p> <p>1.Candidates who have successfully completed the X standard from a recognized institution, with or without Tibetan Language as a subject, but possess a level of proficiency in Tibetan Language equivalent to standard X, are eligible to take the entrance test. Additionally, a level of proficiency in either English or Hindi equivalent to standard X is also necessary.</p>

4-year Integrated B.A. B.Ed.	25	1. The admission to 4-year integrated B.A. B.Ed. programme shall be open to a student who has passed/appeared in 10+2 level, or who has the certificate of Uttar Madhayama or equivalent from a school/University recognised by the government of India.
B.Ed.	25	1. The admission shall be open to students, who have passed graduation with minimum 50% marks in any discipline as Shastri or equivalent from a University recognised by the Government of India. 2. The applicant must have the knowledge of Tibetan language and possess the certificate of class 10 th with Tibetan language as a subject.
