Prof. Jha had delivered a lecture on alternatives to teaching practices for student-teachers. Prof. Jha had suggested the internship may be divided in two broad categories, one as pre-internship experience, in which

student teachers should be exposed to some essentials teaching skills and it should go for 15 days.

The second category should have related to teaching practices as simulated practices, in which the student teachers themselves form a small group and one by one every member of the group will practice the teaching in front of the rest of the members of group and group member are supposed to behave like the school students. He also emphasized on the different components of school attachment programme should be converted in virtual mode for their modalities.
