Subject:- Grant of conditional permission to Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, Varanasi, <u>Uttar Pradesh-</u>221007 for intake capacity of 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24-regarding.

#### Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- 1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, Varanasi, <a href="Uttar Pradesh-221007">Uttar Pradesh-221007</a> inspection of your College was conducted on 02.05.2023 and 03.05.2023 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 under Section 28 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Sowa-Rigpa Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2017", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings:-

Availability of Hospital Staff is 11 against the minimum requirement of 19 (excluding excess). Percentage of available hospital staff is 57.89%.

- 3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the 46<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 07.07.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. dated 14.07.2023 to appear on 20.07.2023 before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to why not the conditional permission to your college with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied for the Academic Year 2023-24. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions vide letter CIHTS/DSR/N/2022-23/1-02 dated 15/07/2023 against the deficiencies conveyed to them.
- 4. Whereas, the college through its representatives, Dr. Dorjee Damdul (Dean, Sowa-Rigpa Depatrment), Dr. Tashi Dawa (HOD, Sowa-Rigpa Department), appeared before the Hearing Committee on 20.07.2023 and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Sowa-Rigpa college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

The last three points depends on the State AYUSH Ministry. The hospital is under construction. The hospital construction will be physically completed by August but even then Sowa-Rigpa has to be recognized as a medical system in the state of UP. They are expecting Gazette notification on Recognition of Sowa-Rigpa as a system of medicine. The college submitted that done have continued communication with the State AYUSH ministry regarding this.

# 5. Functionality of the Hospital:-

The college submitted that except Tsa-Jong (pointer no.4). all the other three therapies are available. The number of treatment are less because the time frame between April to August is a Buddhist Retreat time and holiday season where the number of patients automatically drops down and moreover the eligibility criteria is strictly considered while doing these external treatments.

The college submitted that they will focus more on these procedures from now onwards.

Pointer no. 4 needs expertise which is available in Tibet alone. They are planning for exchange of expertise from Tibet to establish Tsa-Jong.

# Post hearing Submission:

Proof of availability of the procedures submitted.

The numbers of procedures are sufficient as per the general trend in Sowa-Ripga hospitals at the moment.

The shortcoming persists.

- The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Sowa-Rigpa Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2017", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine(NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 49<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 27.07.2023.
- 6. In view of above, the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and it was found that the college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission for the Academic year 2023-24 due to following short comings:
  - a. Duty Roster for non teaching staff and teaching staff is not available as per MSR Sowa- Rigpa 2017.

- b. Shortcomings of 8 hospital staff, Against the minimum requirement of 19 as per MSR Sowa- Rigpa 2017 (Excluding
- c. The details not uploaded in the website as per MSR Sowa- Rigpa 2017.
- 7. However, Board decided to issue warning in accordance of section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 and grant conditional permission to Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh-221007 with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the Academic Session 2023-24 subject to the condition that college shall fulfill the deficiencies as mentioned in above paras by 31st December 2023 as under
  - a. Duty Roster shall be as per MSR Sowa- Rigpa 2017.
  - Hospital staff shall be as per MSR Sowa- Rigpa 2017 b.
  - Website shall be updated as per MSR Sowa- Rigpa 2017.
- Therefore, Conditional Permission is granted to Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh-221007 with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under for the academic session 2023-24 subject to the condition that college is also fulfill the following requirement
  - i. As per MSE (Sowa-Rigpa) 2022 regulation 4 (4) the counselling for admission to Bachelor of Sowa-Rigpa Medicine and Surgery Programme shall be conducted by Sowa-Rigpa Central Counselling Committee (SRCCC) constituted by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine in this behalf and in this process the policy on reservation of the concerned state (if any) in the admission of Sowa-Rigpa under-graduate Programme shall be considered.
- Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 10. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:
  - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Sowa-Rigpa Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2017;

(ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2017 (for Sowa-Rigpa);

- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
- 11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
