Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies conducts Entrance Examination for Admission to various academic programmes viz. P.M., U.M., Shastri, B.Ed., B.A.B.Ed & Acharya. The entrance examination for the academic session 2024-25 shall be held on 23rd June 2024 in two sessions - 09.00 am to 12.00 noon & 02.00 pm to 05.00 pm. Interested candidates seeking admission to these programmes can apply for the admission through the application form available on Institute's website-www.cihts.ac.in
Freeship/Scholarship to the deserving students is available as per Institute norms.

Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies in Sarnath, Varanasi, was envisioned by His Holiness the Dalai Lama and established to preserve the Tibetan Cultural Heritage and to provide educational opportunities for Tibetan and Himalayan youths to study traditional subjects of Buddhist and Tibetan Studies within a modern university framework. This Institute has been recognized by the University Grants Commission (U.G.C.) as a Deemed to be University. The Institute is accredited with NAAC 'A' grade.

Graduates of the Institute can pursue a career as faculty members within the Institute or as research scholars in one of its research departments, such as Restoration, Translation, Rare Buddhist Texts Research, Dictionary, and Tibetan Literature. They can also pursue career as Teachers, Research Scholars, Translators, Interpreters, etc. in other educational institutions in India and abroad, including the Himalayan regions of India, Nepal, and Bhutan, or serve in the Central Tibetan Administration.

Note* Admission to Shastri & Acharya Programmes shall be made on merit and as per availability of the seats.

- Admission will be granted to successful candidates based on merit marks obtained in the entrance examination. Candidate are required to score 25% of marks in each paper, and overall 40% marks in all the papers to qualify for being called for the counselling.
- Entrance Examination will be held at the following Centers – (1) CIHTS, Sarnath, Varanasi (2) Dehradun (3) Darjeeling (4) Shimla (5) Bylakuppe, Mysore (6) Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh and (7) Kathmandu, Nepal. Candidates may fill up their choice accordingly.**
- The reservation of seats shall be as per G.O.I. norms.
- In addition to the advertised seats in each programme, 02 supernumerary seats in each programme have been created under the PM Cares for Children Scheme. Admission in supernumerary seats is subject to eligibility and fulfilment of all the criteria as laid down by the Government of India in the PM Cares for Children Scheme.
