The report of the Sub-Committee meeting held on July 12th, 14th and 15th was put up before the Board by the Registrar of the University on the table during the meeting for considering the cases of daily wagers, prepared on the basis of Circular of Ministry of Labour and Employment F.No. 1/13(3)/2017-15-11 dated 20-04-2017 and accordingly proposal of the University for enhancement in the honorarium of Guest Faculty/contractual/fixed salaries staff in order to maintain proportionate parity likely to be disproportionated on account of enhancement in the wages of daily wagers.

The Board noted that the Finance Committee in its meeting held on 29th July, 2017 under agenda item No. 49.7 considered the recommendation of the Sub-committee and has recommended it for approval by this Board. Then the Board discussed the matter elaborately and observed as under:-

Further, the Board considered the matter relating Faculty of Sowa-Rigpa (medical staff) who are performing the teaching job as well as other allied work for the faculty be given fixed salary(including all) of Rs. 25000-/ per month i.e. equal to the ceiling of Guest Faculty honorarium.

Further the Board heard the Chairman's plea in respect of the matter relating increase in the ceiling of honorarium of Guest Faculty from Rs. 25000/- to Rs. 40000/- p.m. in case the incumbent has income from single source and Rs. 30,000/- in case the person, so engaged, has income from other source like pension etc. establishing comparison with the present enhancement of wages of daily wagers etc. The Board though, in principle, was unanimous with the plea of the Chairman, but in absence of guide lines from concerned agency i.e. UGC / or other body, the proposal relating increase in the ceiling of honorariums of Guest Faculty and other staff of similar category would not be in accordance with the existing norms of UGC, said the Joint Secretary, Govt. of India, Ministry of Culture, New Delhi. The Chairman attracted the attention of the Board again and was of the view that in order to keep the competent teachers/staff continued in the service of the University it has now become hazardous task, as no increase in the honorarium of such staff have been taken into consideration since 2006 in spite of all round enhancement in the wages of others following hikes in prices of essential commodities etc. from time to time. Therefore, in absence of the guidelines of UGC/ other competent body, at present the University would like to compensate the proposed increase in the honorarium i.e. Rs. 15000/- in case of person with single source of income and Rs. 5000/- in case of person with other source of income respectively from its own source in the interest of the smooth functioning of the academic and other related works. This practice will continue till the decision of the UGC/other relevant body relating increase in the honorariums of such staff is received. .. The Joint Secretary asked the University administration to send the proposal to the Administrative Ministry (MOC) for consideration. Further, the Board approved the amendment for engagement of Guest Faculty from July to June.

With above observation the Board accorded its approval, in principle, with condition that the recommendation of the Sub-Committee be sent to MOC for consideration and approval as the matter involves financial implication.

Agenda Minutes of the 49th meeting of Finance Item No. Committee held on July 29, 2017 55.10.5

The Minutes of the Finance Committee meeting held on July, 29, 2017 was discussed and the Board observed as under:

The observation of Audit on payment of scholarship in favour of the Mess Management Committee
was discussed and the Board was not in consonance with the recommendation of the F.C to remit
the scholarship to individual student's account. The Board was of the view that status quo be

maintained i.e. the payment of scholarship be made in favour of Mess Management Committee as no problems or objections have so far been noted on remitting the scholarships to Mess Management Committee, who in turns arrange foodings etc. for the students. Taking these facts in view, the Board decided that the Audit may be replied accordingly.

The matter relating increase in the capacity of the students in take in different courses was discussed elaborately in the light of the recommendation of the Finance Committee and the Board approved it in principle with the condition that the approval of MOC be obtained in the matter.

The Board discussed the matter relating implementation of the $7^{
m th}$ CPC recommendations in the light of the recommendation of the Finance Committee and approved it in principle with the condition that the MOC be approached with estimated financial implications to accord permission for implementation of 7th CPC,

The Board discussed the matter relating enhancement of scholarship of the students in the light of the recommendation of the F.C. and approved it in principle with the condition that approval of the MOC be obtained prior to materialization of enhancement of scholarship for the students.

With above observation, the Board approved the Minutes of the Finance Committee.

Considering Nomination of Jt. Secretary, Govt. of India Agenda Ministry of Culture, New Delhi to remain as august Item No. member of the Board as usual. 55.10.6

The Board discussed the matter relating re-constitution of the New Board and noted that the nomination from the Government to the Board of CUTS, since its inception, has always been represented by the Joint Secretary(Culture), Govt. of India, New Delhi. Moreover, it has been the prevailing practice that BOGs' of all the four academic institutions of Buddhist Studies under the MOC are represented by the Joint Secretary of MOC. Unfortunately, this time the Joint Secretary, Govt. of India, Ministry of Culture has not been nominated to the BOG instead the Director (BTI) has been nominated. . The Board felt that the presence of the Joint Secretary to the Board of CUTS has always been very beneficial in term of his/her guidance, contributions toward quick decision and inspiration to tune the activities towards its goal of objectives. Therefore, the Board unanimously resolved that the Govt. of India, Ministry of Culture be requested to keep the earlier conventional practice of nomination of Jt. Secretary, Govt. of India, Deptt. of Culture. Ministry of Culture, New Delhi continued in the interest of smooth and fair functioning of the University.
