Programme shall be open to a student who has passed or appearing in the 10+2 level or who has the certificate of Uttar Madhyama or equivalent from a school/university recognized by the Government of India 2. The applicant must possess the class X certificate with the Tibetan language as a subject.	Examination Pattern There will be three papers – (a) Teaching Aptitude, General Knowledge and Current Affairs (100 marks) (Objective) (b) Tibetan Language and Literature (50 marks) (Subjective) (c) English Language and Literature or Hindi Language and Literature (50 marks) (Subjective) Note: The level of paper for both languages shall be of class X

- 1. Admission Process:** Admission will be granted based on the candidate's performance in the entrance examination. For B.A. B.Ed. Programme: Candidates must score at least 25% in each paper and a minimum of 40% overall to qualify for counselling.
- 2. Reservation Policy:** Seat reservations will be provided as per the Government of India norms.
- 3. Examination Centres:** The entrance examination will be conducted at the following centres:
(1) CIHTS, Sarnath, Varanasi (2) Dehradun (3) Siliguri (4) Shimla (5) Bylakuppe, Mysuru (6) Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh (7) Mundgod, Karnataka (8) Kathmandu, Nepal. Candidates should indicate their preferred centre while filling the application form.
- 4. Supernumerary Seats under PM CARES Scheme:** In addition to the regular seats, two supernumerary seats per programme are available under the PM CARES for Children Scheme. Admission to these seats will depend on eligibility and fulfilment of all criteria prescribed by the Government of India under this scheme.
