Rules for General Students

- 1. Hostel Wardens and House Leaders must regularly ensure that the student code of conduct is enforced and adhered to.
- 2. All students, senior and junior, must respect and follow the behavioural guidance provided by Hostel Wardens and House Leaders, who are the current enforcers of the disciplinary rules and regulations.
- 3. All students must wear proper attire in classrooms, libraries, offices and during official functions. Female students must wear standard traditional *chupa* (Tibetan dress) and male students must wear proper, clean and visually appealing clothing, mainly collared shirts.
- 4. Lay (non-monastic) students must not keep hairstyles that are visually unappealing. Those keeping traditional Tibetan hairstyles or tantric practitioner hairstyles (if they have received the appropriate hair empowerments) must maintain them properly. Colourful dyes and messy hairstyles that are incompatible with cultural ethical standards are not allowed. If such hairstyles are kept, the first offence will result in head-shaving and a fine of Rs. 150/-, the second offence will result in head-shaving and a fine of Rs. 300/- and the third offence will result in head-shaving and mess-duty for three Sundays.
- 5. Gambling games such as dice are strictly prohibited even during holidays listed in the Institute's calendar. Violators of this rule will be fined Rs. 500/- for the first offence, Rs. 1000/- for the second offence and expulsion from the Institute for one year for the third offence.

- 6. Apart from physical sports, other prohibited games, even if they don't involve gambling like dice etc., are prohibited. Violators will be fined Rs. 150/- for the first offence, Rs. 300/- for the second offence, and Rs. 700/- for the third offence.
- 7. a) Fighting and physical altercations between students are strictly prohibited. Violators of this rule will be put on mess-duty for three Sundays for the first offence and mess-duty for five Sundays for the second offence.
 - b) If weapons such as sticks are used in student fights resulting in injuries, offenders will be expelled for two years. For serious cases, permanent expulsion from the Institute will be imposed.
 - c) Furthermore, if any student engages in an altercation with local residents, they will be immediately handed over to the local police. After the resolution, appropriate disciplinary action will be decided by the Institute. If the student receives a court punishment, they will be permanently expelled from the Institute.
- 8. a) Consumption of alcoholic beverages by any student at any time is prohibited. Violators will be fined Rs. 300/- for the first offence, Rs. 500/- for the second offence and Rs. 1000/- for the third offence along with parents of the student being notified. If violated even after that, the student will be expelled from the Institute for one year.
 - b) The use of intoxicating drugs is strictly prohibited at all times. If used, the student will be expelled for two years. Upon readmission, a written commitment and credible guarantee never to use drugs again is

- required. For a second offence, the student will be permanently expelled from the Institute.
- c) Throughout entire campus premises and vicinity, no student may snuff tobacco products, chew tobacco (*khaini* and *gutka*) or smoke cigarettes. Violators will be fined Rs. 150/- for the first offence, Rs. 300/- for the second offence and Rs. 600/- for the third offence. More than three violations or failure to pay fines on time will result in expulsion from the Institute for one year.
- 9. Stealing will result in appropriate penalties and if proven to be a serious case, permanent expulsion from the Institute will be imposed.
 - a) No student is allowed to go out to watch movies during class time or official functions. Violators will be fined Rs. 300/- for the first offence, messduty for three Sundays for the second offence and mess-duty for four Sundays for the third offence.
 - b) In the Hostels, apart from computers and mobile phones, students are not allowed to keep items that may interfere with studies such as televisions. Watching movies or playing games during self-study time will result in a fine of Rs. 500/- for the first offence and Rs. 1000/- for the second offence.
- 10. Except for office bearers of the Students Welfare Association, Mess Management Committee and Sampradaya Committees, no student is allowed to own bicycles. Furthermore, no student may drive bicycles, motorcycles or cars. Known violators will be fined Rs. 1000/- for the first offence, Rs. 2000/- for the second offence and the student will be expelled from the Institute for one year with the vehicle confiscated for the third offence.

- 11. a) Students should wake up at 5:30 AM in summers and 6:00 AM in winters, freshen-up, do the cleanings, do prayers and offerings, do memorization of root texts and self-study. Room doors must not be locked after 6:00 AM. Violators will be fined Rs. 50/- for the first offence, Rs. 100/- for the second offence and Rs. 300/- for the third offence.
 - b) From 7:45 PM onwards, students may not leave their hostels except for official duties with permission of the office or hostel warden. If permission required for important personal matters: for until 10:30 PM written permission from the hostel warden is required and if permission for longer period than that or overnight stay is required, permission must be obtained from the office before 4:00 PM. Violators will be fined Rs. 250/- for the first offence, Rs. 500/- for the second offence and expulsion for one year from the Institute for the third offence. Research students are allowed to stay until 9:00 PM; violations beyond this time will result in the same penalties mentioned above.
 - c) If students have the opportunity to go to the library during self-study time, they must register their exit and entry times and sign in both the hostel and library registers. Violations will result in appropriate penalties from hostel wardens and house leaders.
- 12. a) From 7:45 PM to 10:00 PM, students must engage in self-study in their rooms; gathering here and there, gossiping, making noise or playing is strictly not allowed. Room doors must not be locked during self-study time. Violators will be fined Rs. 50/- for the first offence, Rs. 100/- for the second offence and Rs. 200/- for the third offence.

- b) During self-study time in four-bedded or eight-bedded rooms, students must read silently and use earphones when listening to lectures to avoid disturbing others. Complaints will result in fines of Rs. 50/- for the first offence, Rs. 100/- for the second offence and Rs. 300/- for the third offence.
- 13. Except for special official duties, everyone must be in bed by 11:00 PM. Lights must be turned off after this time. Violators will be fined Rs. 100/- for the first offence, Rs. 200/- for the second offence and Rs. 300/- for the third offence. Those with particular difficulties must obtain permission from the relevant office.
- 14. During morning and evening class times, no student may go out of the school's main gate without proper leave permission. No student may stay in the hostel during class times without medical leave. Violators will be fined Rs. 250/- for the first offence, Rs. 500/- for the second offence and Rs. 1000/- for the third offence.
- 15. Non-student outsiders are strictly prohibited from staying in student rooms in the hostels. If outsiders are found staying, hostel wardens and house leaders must immediately report their names to the Registrar or the Vice Chancellor, and the office to impose appropriate penalties or expulsion from the Institute. Former students or those not on the current student roster who need accommodation must obtain special permission from the Registrar's office.
- 16. Students must not violate any internal rules of their respective Sampradayas. Violators will be penalized according to the internal rules of each Sampradaya.
- 17. All students must give equal respect to all Indian and Tibetan teachers of this Institute. Likewise, teachers should provide guidance and education to all students

- without discrimination or favouritism. No student should be neglected. Any teacher who observes a student violating rules should immediately note it and report to the hostel warden or office.
- 18. Boys and girls are strictly prohibited from entering each other's hostels. When office bearers of Welfare Committees need to enter the hostels for official work may do so according to special rule no. 4 of the girls' hostel. Any others violating the rule will be fined Rs. 350/- for the first offence, mess-duty for five Sundays for the second offence and expulsion for one year from the Institute for the third offence.
- 19. a) Three official celebrations are permitted in hostels with the hostel warden's permission: the annual farewell for graduating seniors, the celebration of the five Sampradaya Committees and the Mess Management Committee's annual party. However, these celebrations must end no later than 10:00 PM. Along with that, during these celebrations, only Tibetan songs and dances are permitted; other performances are not allowed.
 - b) Apart from the above-mentioned, no parties of classes or departments are allowed. If any special requirements arise, written permission must be sought from the Registrar at least three days in advance.
 - c) During Ladakhi New Year, permission may be granted to Ladakhi students by the Hostel Warden to go out of the hostel between 4:00 AM to 10:00 PM for not more than two days.
 - d) During Parinirvana Commemoration Pujas of the Sampradayas, students must return to their

hostels within fifteen minutes after the Pujas are concluded.

- 20. a) Room allocation in the Hostels at the start of each new academic year will be done by the office as per the allocation rules. Thereafter, as rooms become vacant, they can be allotted by the Hostel Warden and the House Leader according to the rules.
 - b) While moving to another room, furniture such as tables and chairs of the individual rooms must be kept in its own place and should not be carried from one room to another.
- 21. a) No student is allowed to cook food in the Hostels. If caught doing so, a fine of Rs. 250/- for the first time, Rs. 500/- for the second time, Rs. 1000/- and confiscation of cooking equipments for the third time will be imposed. The house leaders of the Mess Management Committee and Student Welfare Association are responsible for monitoring this.
 - b) If required to boil water for medicines and milk or prepare special food for sick students, common kitchen may be used by seeking permission from the house leaders of the Mess Management Committee. This rule applies equally to all students from the Madhayama to Research.
 - c) No student is allowed to keep pets such as dogs, cats, etc., in the hostels. In case of violation of this rule, there will be a fine of Rs. 1000/- and will be required to make a commitment to not keep the same henceforth.
- 22. Non-official phone calls and their improper use during self-study, classes and meetings are strictly prohibited.
- 23. Drama practices and similar activities by student groups should be conducted between 2:00 PM to 6:00 PM,

- avoiding self-study hours. For unavoidable official activities to be conducted during self-study hours, written permission must be obtained from the Registrar or the Vice Chancellor.
- 24. For a sick student requiring immediate travel to hospital from the hostels and for necessary attendants required for the sick student, decisions shall be made by the Hostel Warden or the Medical In-charge of the Student Welfare Association and House Leaders according to the sick student's condition.
- 25. From the time this code of conduct is finalized and notified, the Wardens of the Boys and Girls Hostels shall each maintain a register with the names of the students, recording in it the penalties incurred and signed by the Wardens. The same is to be submitted in writing to the Administrative Office through the Dean of Students to be placed in each student's file. During the handing-taking over of the charge of Hostel Wardens, the register must be handed-taken over.
- 26. For other ethical conduct matters not specified in this code of conduct and particularly for activities during special events, notifications and guidance to be provided by the hostel Wardens or the Institute's Administrative Office at individual occasions.
- 27. Matters relating to violations of the student code of conduct etc. will be recorded in writing and kept in each student's individual file in the office, and character certificates in the future will be issued on its basis.
- 28. As directed by the Supreme Court of India, harassing, mocking or bullying of any new student by senior students are strictly prohibited. If proven guilty of doing so, action as per rules will be taken.

Second

Special Rules for the Monastics

- 1. Monastics are not allowed to keep long hair during any season (summer or winter), wear sleeved clothes in summer and wear only white undershirts without their upper vest (*stod 'gag*). They are not allowed to go to pujas, classes, meetings, library, offices and likewise go out of the main gate without proper monastic attire and wearing only lower garments like skirts. Besides, they are not allowed to violate monastic dress code anywhere on campus. For such violations, guidance and advice will be given in the first instance of violation, a fine of Rs. 250/for the second time and Rs. 500/- for the third time will be imposed. The responsibility of this rule shall be earnestly borne by the hostel Wardens, House Leaders and the Khenpos of the five Sampradayas collectively.
- 2. If any monastic student faces difficulty maintaining their vows during their stay at this Institute and needs to renounce their vows, they must inform their parent monastery or parents. After receiving documentary proof of having fully renounced the vows, and after having reported the matter to the office, they should make proper confessions during Parinirvana Pujas of their respective Sampradayas and in case they belong to the Center for Teacher Education and Sowa Rigpa Department to their respective departments
- 3. Apart from that, any monastic student found to have violated their monastic celibacy vows shall be expelled from the Institute.

Third

Special Rules for the Girls Hostel

In addition to the general code of conduct, the special rules for the Girls Hostel are as follows:

- 1. Girls must return inside their hostel compound by 6:30 PM in winters and 7:00 PM in summers. The hostel warden will notify seasonal time changes at respective times. Students who are late until the start of self-study session without sanctioned leave will have to pay a fine of Rs. 2/- per minute.
- 2. If a student is delayed for an hour beyond self-study time without permission from the hostel warden, the matter must be reported to the office through the hostel warden and appropriate decision shall be taken.
- 3. Girls are not allowed to seek leave from self-study except for official duties or if granted special permission. Any violation in this matter will be directly reported to the administration by the hostel warden.
- 4. Other than one's mother, if any outsider has come to meet girls must do so in front of the hostel gate and are not allowed to go inside the hostel. The visitor's name, the student's name, purpose of visit, visitor's phone number and time must be clearly recorded in the gatekeeper's register. If anyone enters girls' hostel without permission, that person's name should be submitted to the office and investigated. Upon investigation by the Warden, the visited girl student will be fined Rs. 300/- for the first time, Rs. 600/- for the second time and for the third time the student will be expelled from the Institute for one year.

- 5. Except staff specifically sent by the office and Warden of the Girls' Hostel, no one is allowed to enter individual rooms of the girls.
- 6. No girl student is allowed to go to boys' hostel, except for official work. If any house leaders and office bearers of any welfare associations, general or specific, need to meet girls for official work purpose, they must do so in the common room of the relevant association/ committees and not enter individual rooms of the students in the boys' hostel.
- 7. During Mess and Sampradaya parties, girls must have returned to their hostels no later than 10:00 PM. During Sampradayas' Parinirvana pujas being held, they must have returned to their hostel not later than fifteen minutes after the conclusion of the pujas.
- 8. In the case of violations of regulations not specified above, hostel warden and house leader, after discussing with each other, shall determine appropriate penalties.

These regulations are based on the one that existed before which was revised and finalized in a joint meeting of the Principal and the Teachers in February 1975, that in which a few amendments were made by the Office of the Principal on 25th August 1983, that which was amended, finalized and notified by the Office of the Principal on 21st September 1985. On that basis, in view of the certain new violations of rules in the past few years, revisions were done in joint meetings of the Director, faculty members of the Sampradayas, representatives of Student Welfare Association, teachers, wardens of the boys' and girls' hostels on 5th December 1994 and 2^{nd &} 10th January 1995. Further, in a joint meeting of the Director, Dean of Students, Chairperson of the Disciplinary Committee, Dean of Tibetan Sowa Rigpa Department, Khenpos of the five

Sampradayas, Wardens of the boys' and girls' hostels held on 28th & 29th of February and 2nd of March 2008, some additional sections were added, the monastic section was kept as a separate section and some amendments to the penalties were also made. With these amendments, a revised draft was prepared on 21st July 2008 after deliberations in a joint meeting of the Director, Dean of Students, Chairperson of the Disciplinary Committee, Faculty members of the five Sampradayas, Wardens of the boys' and girls' hostels, representatives of the Student Welfare Association and House Leaders. This draft was further revised with amendments to the penalties after deliberations on the matter in a joint meeting of the Vice Chancellor, Dean of Students, Khenpos of the five Sampradayas, Head of the Mool Shastra Department, Dean of Shabd Vidya Faculty, Dean of Sowa Rigpa Faculty, Representative of the Centre for Teacher Education, Wardens of the girls' and boys' Hostels, Representatives of the Student Welfare Association and Mess Management Committee held on 21st December 2024. These revised rules were finalized and notified by the office of the Vice Chancellor under Article 35 of this Institute's rules and regulations and is to be implemented from the 15th of January 2025.

Guidelines for Students seeking Medical Leave and other Leaves

- 1. Those sick students who need to stay in a hospital within Varanasi area, unless they have a medical certificate from the Student Welfare Association that is supported by the Hostel Wardens and the House Leaders, other medical leaves, regardless of whether or not they have a doctor's medical certificate, their medical leave will not be counted in attendance records for respective semester's required no. of attendance in classes.
- 2. Those unwell students who need continued rest as per doctor's instructions after returning back from outside hospitals, those with sudden illnesses and those who have suffered serious injuries must stay in the Institute's infirmary only. They should request leave from the Hostel Warden along with a doctor's recommendation.
- 3. Girl students who become unwell for a few days due to monthly [period] health problem may be granted two days of leave; however, this leave must be requested following the same procedure of medical leave.
- 4. Outstation leaves, medical leaves, special leaves and session leaves etc. must be sought by submitting application to the administrative office as per general rules. Those on session leave may join in the next session, but they are not entitled to scholarship beyond a total of twelve months.
- 5. In each academic year, students may be granted special and emergency leave for ten or twelve days. Those who need to travel more than three days by train may by granted twelve days, for others it should not exceed ten days. Sundays and official holidays are also

counted within these days. The offices of the Registrar and the Vice Chancellor will decide from time to time whether such leave is grantable or not. In sum, this leave is merely a provision for students' needs and not an entitlement. Approved leaves will also not be counted in class attendance records of the respective semesters. If leave of absence exceeds ten or twelve days, the student will be expelled from the Institute for that academic session. Furthermore, any student needing to take special or emergency leave must obtain permissions from: 1) Khenpo of the relevant Sampradaya, 2) House leader of the Mess Management Committee, 3) Hostel Warden, 4) Dean of Students, 5) in case ill, Doctor's recommendation, and 6) Registrar and Vice Chancellor. Students are not allowed to leave without permission granted by all the concerned authorities.

- 6. Students on medical leave and staying in the hostels or in Hospitals within Varanasi area will continue to receive scholarships if they have a medical treatment certificate from the Student Welfare Association. Those who travel to other locations will not receive scholarships.
- 7. If a student leaves the Institute without approved leave, a fine of Rs. 1000/- for one day and Rs. 2000/- for the second day will be imposed. If the absence exceeds two days, they will be expelled from the Institute for one academic session. If absence extends to one week, expulsion for two years or permanent expulsion whichever action required will be decided by the office of the Vice Chancellor.

This regulation is based on the one revised and notified on 21st September 1985 which was further revised on 2nd & 10th of January 1995 in joint meetings of the Director, faculty

members of the Sampradayas, Student Welfare Association, teachers and wardens of boys' and girls' hostels. A draft with few amendments and revision made in the meetings held on 28th & 29th of February, 2nd of March and 21st of July 2008 was revised after deliberations in the joint meeting of the Director, Dean of Students, Chairperson of the Disciplinary Committee, faculty members of the Sampradayas, Wardens of boys' and girls' hostels, representatives of Student Welfare Association and House Leaders held on 21st of July 2008. Further, the draft was revised after deliberations in a joint meeting of the Vice Chancellor, Dean of Students, Khenpos of the Sampradayas, Head of the Mool Shastra Department, Dean of the Faculty of Shabd Vidya, Dean of the Faculty of Sowa Rigpa, Representative of the Center for Teacher Education, Wardens of boys' and girls' hostels, representatives of Student Welfare Association and House Leaders of the Mess Management Committee held on the 21st of December 2024. These regulations, finalized and notified by the office of the Vice Chancellor under Article 35 of this Institute's rules and regulations, are to be implemented from 15th of January 2025.

Rules

Rules for electing representatives of the Students Welfare Association

- 1. The election process for electing members of Student Welfare Association must be conducted by the Khenpos of the five Sampradayas, representative of the Center for Teacher Education and the outgoing Student Welfare Association members under the direct supervision of either the Vice Chancellor or the Registrar and their representatives.
- 2. Every year before the election, the list of voters from each Sampradaya must be received with signature of the relevant teacher. Regular students who have participated fully in the previous semester's examinations and research students are eligible to participate in the election.
- 3. For electing the candidates from each of the four Sampradayas, ballot papers with no more than four names written on them by all the voters must be collected. From these, the election supervisors must determine at least four candidates for each position of the association based on the highest votes. However, for candidates from the Yungdrung Bon Sampradaya and the Center for Teacher Education, voters may write no more than two names on the ballot paper, and from these the election supervisors must determine at least two candidates based on the highest votes.
- 4. Following qualifications must be fulfilled in order to be nominated as a candidate of the Students Welfare Association member:

- a) Be a regular student of this Institute and have passed all the exams of the recently held semester examinations.
- b) Not be a graduating student or a first-year student of the Purva Madhyama.
- c) Have passed exams of the two previous examinations. Those whose exam results are pending may participate as candidates, but if they fail exams when the results are declared later, elected members must resign and a by-election must be held.
- d) Not have faced disciplinary expulsion as penalty by their Sampradayas or the Institute's administration for violations of rules or shortage of class attendance during the previous two academic years.
- e) Not currently serving as a member of an individual Sampradaya Committee or a house leader.
- 5. Any candidate not meeting any of the above qualifications will be withdrawn, even if they receive a majority of votes.
- 6. Students who are nominated as candidates may not seek withdrawal from their candidacy.
- 7. Voting will be conducted on the finalized list of candidates, and those elected by majority of votes will be declared as members of the association.
- 8. Students who have been declared as elected may not resign from membership of the association except in the cases of illness or complete withdrawal from the Institute.
- If any student found to have campaigned or attempted to influence the election supervisors directly or indirectly to get elected, they will be withdrawn from candidature.

- If discovered after election, they will be expelled from their status as a member of the association.
- 10. Any disputes related to the election will be decided by majority vote of the election supervisors. If this is not possible, the Vice Chancellor or the Registrar shall take a decision.

This regulation, notified under signature and seal on 4th of January 1995, revised with few amendments after deliberations in a joint meeting of the Vice Chancellor, Dean of Students Welfare, Khenpos of the Sampradayas, Head of the Mool Shastra Department, Dean of the Shabd Vidya Faculty, Dean of the Sowa Rigpa Faculty, Representative of the Center for Teacher Education, Wardens of the Boys and Girls Hostels, Representatives of the Students Welfare Association and the Mess Management Committee held on 21st of December 2024, has been finalized and notified by the office of the Vice Chancellor under Article 35 of the Institute's rules and is to be implemented from the 15th of January 2025.

Rules for electing members of the Mess Management Committee

- 1. The election process for Mess Management Committee members must be conducted by the Khenpos of the five Sampradayas and the outgoing Mess Management Committee members under the direct supervision of either the Vice Chancellor or the Registrar.
- 2. Every year before the election, the list of voters from each Sampradaya must be received with the signature of the relevant teacher. Except regular students who have appeared fully in the previous semester's examinations and research students, others are not eligible to cast vote.
- 3. For each of the four Sampradayas' candidates for election, upon collecting the ballot papers with not more than four names written on them by all voters, the election supervisors must determine at least four candidates from them for each position of the committee based on the highest votes. However, for the Yungdrung Bon Sampradaya and the Center for Teacher Education, upon collecting ballot papers with not more than two names written on them by their respective voters, the election supervisors must determine at least two candidates from them based on the highest votes.
- 4. Following qualifications are required to be fulfilled in order to be a member of the committee:
 - a) Must be a regular student of this Institute and have passed all the exams of the recently held semester examinations.
 - b) Must not be a graduating student or a first-year student of the Purva Madhyama.

- c) Must not have failed exams in the recent two previous examinations. Those whose exam results are pending may enter as candidates, but if declared as fail at the time of result declaration, those elected members must resign and a by-election must be held.
- d) Not have faced disciplinary expulsion as a penalty from their Sampradayas or the Institute's administration for violations of rules or shortage of class attendance during the recently completed academic year.
- e) Has to be someone not currently serving as a member of Student Welfare Association, Sampradaya Welfare Committees and as a House Leader.
- 5. Any candidate not fulfilling any of the above qualifications should be withdrawn, even if they receive a majority of votes.
- 6. Those nominated as candidates are not allowed to seek withdrawal from their candidacy.
- 7. Voting will be conducted on the finalized list of candidates and those elected by majority vote will be declared as members of the committee.
- 8. Students who have been declared as elected members may not resign from membership of the committee except in the cases of illness or complete withdrawal from the Institute.
- 9. Any disputes related to the election will be decided by majority vote of the election supervisors. If this is not possible, the Vice Chancellor or the Registrar shall take the decision.

As agreed upon in the joint meeting of the In-charges of the five Sampradayas, Hostel Wardens and the Director held on 25th August 2000, this regulation was finalized and notified.

Further, on the basis of the one slightly revised and notified again on 23rd August 2003, after deliberation in a joint meeting of the Vice Chancellor, Dean of Students, Khenpos of the Sampradayas, Head of the Mool Shastra Department, Dean of the Faculty of Shabd Vidya, Dean of the Faculty of Sowa Rigpa, Representative of Center for Teacher Education, Wardens of the Boys and Girls Hostels, Representatives of the Student Welfare Association and Mess Management Committee, revisions were done along with few amendments to the regulation. It was finalized and notified under Article 35 of this Institute's rules and regulations by the office of the Vice Chancellor and it is to be implemented from the 15th of January 2025.

Rules for electing House Leader of Maya Devi Girls' Hostel

- The election process of the Maya Devi Girls' Hostel House Leader must be conducted by outgoing House Leaders under the direct supervision of either the Vice Chancellor or the Registrar or an election officer appointed by the office.
- 2. Every year before the election, the House Leader must submit to the office the list of voters with signature of the relevant Hostel Warden. Except regular students who have appeared fully in the examinations of the most recently completed academic session, others are not eligible to cast vote.
- 3. For the hostel's House Leader candidature, upon collection of the ballot papers with no less than four names written on them by all the voters, the election supervisor must finalize no more than four candidates based on majority votes.
- 4. The following qualifications must be fulfilled to enter the candidature of Maya Devi Girls' Hostel House Leader:
 - a) Must be a regular student of the Institute and have passed all the examinations of the recently completed semester.
 - b) Must not be a graduating student or a first-year student of the Purva Madhyama.
 - c) Must not have failed examinations in the two recently completed semester examinations. Those awaiting declaration of examination results may participate as candidates, but if declared fail at the time of results declaration, even if elected they must resign and by-elections must be held.

- d) Must not have faced disciplinary expulsion as penalty from either their Sampradayas or the Institute's administration for violations of rules or faced shortage of required class attendance in the recently completed two academic years.
- 5. Any candidate not fulfilling any of the above qualifications will be withdrawn from candidature, even if they have received a majority of votes.
- 6. Students who are nominated as candidates may not seek withdrawal from their candidature.
- 7. After collecting ballots in the name of the finalized list of candidates, declaration of the elected House Leader to be made as per majority of votes.
- 8. Any student who has been elected and declard as the House Leader may not seek resignation except in the cases of illness or if they withdraw permanently from the Institute.
- 9. If any student is found to have campaigned for themselves or attempted to influence the election officers directly or indirectly, they will be removed from candidature. If discovered after election, they will be removed from the house leader position.
- 10. Any disputes related to the election will be resolved by decision taken by the majority of the election supervisors. If this is not possible, either the Vice Chancellor or the Registrar shall take the final decision.

Rules for electing representatives of Students Association of Performing Arts

- All students from Purva Madhyama first-year to Uttar Madhyama second-year automatically become members of the Students Association of Performing Arts. Shastri and Acharya students, and research students, may join the association voluntarily. Representatives of the Students Association of Performing Arts will be elected from among all these members.
- 2. The election process for the representatives of the Students Association of Performing Arts must be conducted by the outgoing committee representatives under the direct supervision of either the Registrar, the Dean or the Deputy Registrar.
- 3. Every year before the election, list of voters with the signature of the chairperson must be submitted to the office by the outgoing committee.
- 4. The Students Association of Performing Arts consists of the following five members: 1) Chairperson, 2) Vice Chairperson, 3) Secretary, 4) Treasurer, and 5) Assistant Treasurer.
- 5. The Chairperson of the Students Association of Performing Arts must be an Uttar Madhyama second-year student.
- 6. All voters must vote by writing no more than four names on their ballot papers when voting for the candidates of the committee representatives.
- 7. To become a committee representative, the following qualifications are required to be fulfilled:

- a. Must be a regular student of this Institute and must have passed all examinations of the recently completed semester.
- b. Must not be a graduating student or a Purva Madhyama first-year student.
- c. Must not have failed examinations in the recently completed previous semester. Those awaiting semester examination results may be candidates, but if they fail in exams when the results are declared, elected representatives must resign and by-elections must be held.
- d. Must not have faced disciplinary expulsion as a penalty from their respective Sampradayas or the Institute's administration for violations of rules or have faced shortage of required number of class attendance during the past two academic years.
- e. Must not be currently serving as a member of a Sampradaya Committee, Student Welfare Association, or as a House Leader.
- 8. Any candidate who does not fulfil any of the above qualifications will be withdrawn from the candidature, even if they receive a majority of votes.
- 9. Students who are nominated as candidates may not withdraw from their candidature.
- 10. After the ballots are collected, committee representatives will be announced according to majority of votes.
- 11. Except in the cases of illness or permanent withdrawal from the Institute, any student elected and announced may not resign from the position of representative.

12. Any disputes related to the election will be resolved by the election supervisor - either the Registrar, the Dean, or the Deputy Registrar.

These regulations, notified under the signature and seal on 11th February 2004, the ordinance which was notified under the signature and seal on 4th January 1995, was deliberated and revised with few amendments in a joint meeting of the Vice Chancellor, Dean of Students, Khenpos of the Sampradayas, Head of the Mool Shastra Department, Dean of the Faculty of Shabd Vidya, Dean of the Faculty of Sowa Rigpa, Representative of the Center for Teacher Education, Wardens of the boys' and girls' Hostels, Representatives of the Students Welfare Association and Mess Management Committee held on 21st December 2024. The revised regulation, finalized and notified under Article no. 35 of this Institute's rules, is to be implemented from the 15th of January 2025.
