ORDER

As per the guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the Ministry of Education, Government of India, it is mandatory for all the students of Higher Education Institutions to create and maintain their Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID, effective from 2021 onwards. The ABC ID is a 12-digit unique identifier, linked with the student's Aadhaar, that maintains a secure digital record of all academic credits earned during the course of study. This academic data can only be shared through the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID, which requires an active Aadhaar card.

It enables students to transfer academic credits from one institution to another. Further, the students can continue to accumulate credits for further education at any stage of life. This also facilitates and ensures credibility of academic records for higher studies and employment.

Students without Aadhaar Card

It has been observed through a recent survey of our Institute that several students still do not possess an Aadhaar Card, which is essential for generating the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID and for sharing academic data with the Government of India. The Institute has already organized two Aadhaar enrolment camps and additionally facilitated visits to the Aadhaar Centre.

All the students who are yet to obtain their Aadhaar Card are hereby directed to approach any authorized Aadhaar Centre or Post Office at the earliest, and complete the enrolment process, and then submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card to the Nodal Officer, NAD-CIHTS, positively by 20th November 2025.

Students with Inactive Aadhaar Card

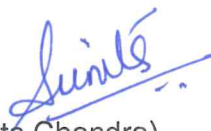
Certain students already hold an Aadhaar card, but their Aadhaar cards have become inactive due to issues such as loss of linked mobile number, data mismatch, etc. Such students must get their Aadhaar details corrected or restored at the authorized Aadhaar Centre or Post Office by themselves and submit the updated Aadhaar details to the Nodal Officer, NAD-CIHTS by 20th November 2025.

Failure to Create/Restore Aadhaar Card

acknowledgment slip, creation/restoration attempt dates, status, rejection message, etc. depicting the date and time by 20th November 2025.

Non-compliance with this directive may adversely impact the processing of your academic records and related benefits.

Therefore, all concerned students are strictly instructed to comply with these directions without fail.
