## ORDER

As per the guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the Ministry of Education, Government of India, it is mandatory for all the students of Higher Education Institutions to create and maintain their Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID, effective from 2021 onwards. The ABC ID is a 12-digit unique identifier, linked with the student's Aadhaar, that maintains a secure digital record of all academic creditsearned during the course of study. This academic data can only be shared through the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID, which requires an active Aadhaar card.

It enables students to transfer academic credits from one institution to another. In addition, the students can continue to accumulate credits for further education at any stage of life. This also facilitates and ensures credibility of academic records for higher studies and employment.

Following the recent update from the UGC regarding foreign national students and the National Academic Depository (NAD), it has been informed that the UGC has initiated the process of creating ABC IDs for foreign national students upon submission of the required documents.

Therefore, all foreign national students who do not yet possess an ABC ID are requested to fill out the Google Form provided below by 5th November 2025.
