1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh- 221007 (SWR0653)**, inspection of your College was conducted on **21.07.2025 & 22.07.2025 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the Permission with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course under Section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.**
2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Sowa-Rigpa Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2023, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there-under.
3. Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the **137th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **30.07.2025**. On careful examination of the assessment report, it was found that **your college is fulfilling the notified & approved criteria for issuance of Permission with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course in accordance with regulation 3(1)(h)(i) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Sowa-Rigpa Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023 under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020, for the academic session 2025-26.**

"DECISION"

4. **Therefore, Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh-221007 (SWR0653), is hereby granted with Permission in UG (BSRMS) course with intake capacity of 15 seats for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with regulation 3(1)(h)(i) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Sowa-Rigpa Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023 under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020, for the academic session 2025-26.**
5. **The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:**
 - i. As per MSE (Sowa-Rigpa) 2022 regulation 4 (4) the counselling for admission to Bachelor of Sowa-Rigpa Medicine and Surgery Programme shall be conducted by Sowa-Rigpa Central Counselling Committee (SRCCC) constituted by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine in this behalf and in this process the policy on reservation of the concerned state (if any) in the admission of Sowa-Rigpa undergraduate Programme shall be considered.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
7. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular or the subsequent academic year.**

8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 30th December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
 - All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Sowa-Rigpa Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023.
 - All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2022 (for Sowa-Rigpa);and
10. The fulfilment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
